Sales

Our perseverance paid off during this pivotal summer period with several fine sales already been made or still in progress. The BGYB team was able to adapt and respond swiftly and attentively to customer enquiries. It is with great pleasure that we announce that the BGYB team has closed 10 sales since the last issue of our Episode in Spring 2023.

Notable sales include the Catana 65 S/Cat TRAMONTANE, as well as the Maxi Dolphin S/Y SHAMLOR, the Mylius S/Y BLACK LEGEND S, and the beautiful Mylius S/Y DAGUET². With 6 sales currently in progress, we expect this list to continue to grow.
