Following the 2 record years of 2021 and 2022, the market is slowly but surely achieving better results over the years, which reassures us that our expansion strategies are efficient. The initial months of this year saw a lot of activity; a very promising year is ahead of us regarding yacht sales, given we already have many in progress, and also for yacht charters, considering the large number of contracts we already have signed.

Sales

Over the winter, our perseverance has borne fruit with several successful sales already concluded or in progress. The BGYB team has demonstrated adaptability and responded promptly to customer inquiries. We are pleased to announce that since the last issue of our Fall 2023 Episode, the BGYB team has closed 10 sales. Notable sales include the sailing yachts Swan 76 SILANDRA V, CNB 76 FIFTY FIFTY and Futuna 70 ICHTUS, as well as the motor yachts Goldfish 46 Bulett AXELLE and Hinckley Talaria Picnic Boat 37 BLUE MOON VI. With 10 more sales currently underway, we anticipate this list to grow further.

Our sales fleet has also gained several prestigious listings; among the motor yachts, the Couach 2100 Open WILD, Lobster 65 OLYMPIC MARITIME, and 65^{ft} Gentleman Yacht KITIKAE, among the multihulls, the amazing GP 70 CATCH ME and Ice Cat 67 USODA, and among the sailing yachts, the 130^{ft} Cutter Rigged Sloop ONYX 2, Sangermani 85 QUARTA SANTA MARIA, Van de Stadt 84 HEIDENSKIP, Ocean Carbon 82 AEGIR, 82^{ft} Trehard Aluminium Sloop DANJGO TOO, and Swan 58 SHINE.

Charter

Over the past few months, the charter department has shown remarkable perseverance and is achieving amazing results for this beginning of the year! We are pleased to announce that we have already signed quite a lot of contracts for the year 2024. It is worth noting that our clients have booked their charters earlier than ever before!

The BGYB Fleet has never been so large; we are approaching having 30 yachts available for charter! Notably with 4 cutting-edge yachts: the Swan 108 FANCY, the Catamaran Sunreef 80 Eco APOLLO 99, the McConaghy 75 JACK, and the Lagoon 77 MANE ET NOCTE. 




